Question:

Explain the criteria that determine whether the QF should be on Occasional Delivery or Time of Delivery Service.

Response:

The terms and conditions of the Occasional Delivery Energy Service tariff (Rate Code E50) and Time of Delivery Service tariff (Rate Code E52) are stated in our South Dakota Electric Rate Book, Section No. 9, Sheets 1 – 10. We note that compensation for Occasional Delivery Energy Service is limited to a maximum of 2,000 kWh delivered per month. Given this limitation, the customer may select either the Occasional Delivery or Time of Delivery tariff. Key factors to be considered in making that selection include the system type such as wind or solar, system size, expected capacity factors, and generation patterns (on-peak, off-peak).

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
