Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act¹ and Section 35.13 of the regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”),² MidAmerican Energy Company (“MidAmerican”) respectfully submits a Certificate of Concurrence and a concurrence tariff record for MidAmerican’s eTariff database to reflect its incorporation by reference of the “Remote Local Balancing Authority Generator Interchange Agreement Between Interstate Power and Light Company and MidAmerican Energy Company” (which is designated by MidAmerican Rate Schedule No. 133) that has already been filed by Interstate Power and Light Company (“IPL”) and accepted by FERC.

I. Description of filing

On August 14, 2018 in Docket No. ER18-2210, IPL submitted for filing a Remote Local Balancing Authority Generator Interchange Agreement between IPL (as the Alliant West Local Balancing Authority) and MidAmerican (as the MidAmerican Local Balancing Authority and as the owner of the Prairie Wind Farm) (“August 14 Filing”). The Remote Local Balancing Authority Generator Interchange Agreement was accepted for filing in an unpublished letter order.³

MidAmerican is submitting a concurrence tariff record (Rate Schedule No. 133) to incorporate the agreement into MidAmerican's eTariff database and a Certificate of Concurrence with respect to the rate schedule.

II. Section 35.13 filing requirements

MidAmerican provides the following information pursuant to Section 35.13 of the Commission's regulations. Most of the information required by Section 35.13 was submitted by IPL in its Transmittal Letter in Docket No. ER18-2210. To the extent necessary, MidAmerican respectfully asks the Commission to waive the requirements to provide any additional information beyond that submitted below.

MidAmerican asks that the tariff record become effective on October 15, 2018, the same date that the Remote Local Balancing Authority Generator Interchange Agreement became effective pursuant to the October 12 Order. To the extent necessary, MidAmerican requests waiver of the notice provisions at Section 35.3 of the Commission's regulations.⁵
