This is to inform you that on May 1, 2019, Black Hills Power, Inc. d/b/a Black Hills Energy (“Black Hills Energy”) filed a request for approval from the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission for an adjustment to the company’s Cogeneration and Small Power Production Service Generation Credit Rate, to become effective on June 1, 2019. Black Hills Energy has calculated a seasonal, solar and wind, peak and off-peak rate(s). The requested Generation Credit Rate are:

100 kW or less Wind Project

Black Hills Energy is required to update the Generation Credit Rate every two years for qualified facilities with a design capacity of 100 kW or less. The Current Generation Credit Rate is \$0.0275 / kWh.
