EXCEPTION BETWEEN CODINGTON-CLARK * OF AGREEMENT
ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., AND *
NORTHWESTERN CORPORATION *

Codington-Clark Electric Cooperative, Inc., ("Cooperative")
and NorthWestern Corporation d/b/a NorthWestern Energy,
("NorthWestern") state to the Commission and moves the Commission
as follows:

1. Petitioners are electric service providers with assigned
electric service territories in South Dakota. The Thorson Legacy
Trust owns the Northeast Quarter of Section 13, Township 113,
North of Range 57, West of the 5th P.M., Clark County, South
Dakota, which is within the service territory of Cooperative.

2. At the request of the land owners, Cooperative and
NorthWestern have entered into a Consent and Agreement for
Electric Service in Assigned Service Territory of Another Electric
Supplier (the "Agreement"). The Agreement is filed herewith. The
Request and Consent of the land owner is included with the
Agreement.

3. The Agreement will result in adequate service to the
consumer and will promote efficient and economical use and
development of the electric system of each petitioning
cooperative.

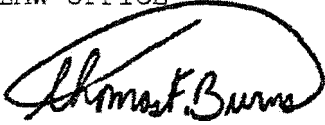
4. Petitioners request approval of the Agreement.

5. This matter is governed by SDCL 49-34A-42 and 49-34A-55.

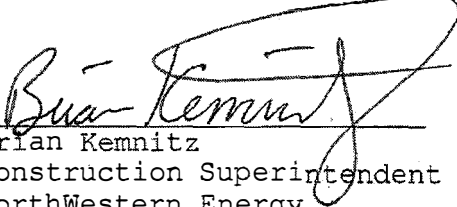
