**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On May 27, 2026, the Commission received a filing from Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) for approval of its tariff revision to Section 1.05 of its South Dakota Rate Book. Otter Tail proposes to implement a new Direct Payment Agreement.

The revised tariff sheets are as follows:

On May 28, 2026, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 12, 2026, to interested entities and persons on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 49-34A and ARSD 20:10:13.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on July 14, 2026, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff recommended approval of the tariff revisions with an August 1, 2026, effective date. Finding the revisions to be just and reasonable, the Commission voted unanimously to approve the revisions, effective August 1, 2026. It is therefore

**ORDERED**, that Otter Tail's request to revise its aforementioned tariff sheets is hereby granted, and the revisions are approved, effective August 1, 2026.
