Montana-Dakota Utilities hereby petitions the Commission for an Order granting intervention in the above captioned proceeding. In support of its Petition, Montana-Dakota states as follows:

1. On December 2, 2019 SDIP filed a request with the Commission for waiver of Lost and Unaccounted for Calculations for 2020.
2. Montana-Dakota is one of two direct customers of SDIP and through tariffs and contracts, the costs of SDIP service to Montana-Dakota are passed through to Montana-Dakota's customers.
3. L&U accountings have become an issue since the addition of Ring-Neck Energy facilities in Onida, SD onto the existing SDIP system. The development of procedures for accounting and reporting is important and Montana-Dakota seeks to be represented as these matters are determined by the parties and/or the Commission.
4. The interests of Montana-Dakota in this proceeding are unique and cannot be fully and adequately represented by the existing parties.
5. Montana-Dakota seeks to add Brett Koenecke, Karl Liepitz and Tamie Aberle to the service list.

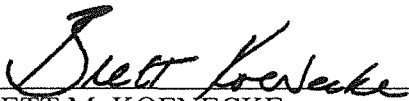
