Yes, the Company provides a Lifeline application immediately in the welcome packet of every new customer. A copy of the application is included.

Data Request No. 1-2: Please describe the Company's current broadband offerings, including technologies used and speed advertised, and any plans the Company has to expand those offerings.

Response:

James Valley Wireless currently offers EVDO mobile data at speeds of as much as 3Mb download and 1Mb upload. The Company is currently upgrading its wireless network to 4G and expects to offer speeds of as much as 25Mb download and 10Mb upload.
