Responses To Staff Data Requests**

North American Local, LLC ("North American") hereby submits these responses to the following data requests of Staff:

1.1 Provide a list of all prepaid plans and services that are looking to be offered in the State of South Dakota? Will North American provide wireless service to customers not eligible for the Federal Lifeline support? Provide a list and pricing for all plans and services.

Response:

North American will offer wireless services to Lifeline eligible subscribers as well as those subscribers who are not Lifeline eligible. As an ETC, North American must meet or exceed the Lifeline Minimum Service Standards. North American's current ETC and Non-ETC plans are below:

Lifeline Plans:

Choice Mobile Plus - \$0.00/Month

Free Smartphone, 1,000 voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages, 100 MB data

Choice Mobile Limited - \$9.99/Month

Free Smartphone, unlimited voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages, 1 GB data

Choice Mobile Unlimited Blue - \$19.99/Month

Free Smartphone, unlimited voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages, 2 GB data

Choice Mobile Unlimited Red - \$19.99/Month

Free Smartphone, unlimited voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages, 3 GB data

Choice Home Unlimited - \$24.99/Month

Free fixed wireless voice terminal, unlimited domestic local and long distance service

Non-Lifeline Plans:

Choice Mobile - \$9.99/Month

Free Smartphone, 1,000 voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages

Choice Mobile Plus - \$24.99/Month

Free Smartphone, unlimited voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages, 100 MB data

Choice Mobile Unlimited - \$29.99/Month

Free Smartphone, unlimited voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages, 1 GB data

Choice Mobile Unlimited Blue - \$44.99/Month

Free Smartphone, unlimited voice minutes, unlimited SMS messages, 2 GB data

1.2 What company owned facilities within the State of South Dakota will be utilized in the provision of wireless Lifeline services?

Response:

North American does not presently have facilities in the State of South Dakota. The equipment used to transport subscriber traffic includes, but is not limited, to the below listed equipment. Our core switching equipment is located at 1100 White Street, Atlanta, GA. Through our IXC, CLEC and carrier interconnection agreements, North American has connectivity to the PSTN and ability to serve customers throughout the USA as well as most international destinations. North American's switching equipment and network allows the traffic to be carried and controlled across North American's network and equipment.

1.3 If providing Lifeline services through the resale of another carrier's facilities, identify whose network North American plans to utilize and provide applicable coverage maps outlining voice and internet connectivity.

Response:

North American is interconnected to Wireless providers, and its coverage area shall mirror that of Sprint, Verizon and AT&T on the State of South Dakota.

1.4 How will North American provide access to the public switched network?

Response:

North American receives signaling from its wireless provider. If North American decides to process the call, the call is routed to North American's network for call processing and termination to the PSTN over its carrier interconnection agreements.

1.5 Does North American have plans to invest or build infrastructure with the State of South Dakota to facilitate the offering of wireless lifeline services?

Response:

North American always seeks opportunities to lower its broadband costs to subscribers and if a business case can be made for the deployment of facilities within the State of South Dakota, North American shall do so.

1.6 Provide applicable financial information for North American as described in its application.

Response:

North American will separately file its confidential Profit Loss and Balance Sheet under seal.

1.7 What jurisdictions does North American provide services that generate revenue outside of the Lifeline program?

Response:

North American currently provides non-Lifeline mobile and fixed residential wireless services in Alabama, Michigan, Minnesota and Wisconsin. North American also resells its transport services to other ETCs, Non-ETC carriers, and aggregators. Additionally, North

American also provides end-user customer services to several other carriers. Each of these revenues are unrelated to North American's Lifeline revenues.
