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On June 22, 2026, Commission Counsel filed a Letter Regarding Consideration of a Waiver of Certain Telecommunications Annual Reporting Requirements for this year and or future years. Specifically, the letter requested the Commission consider granting a waiver of ARSD 20:10:32:12 and ARSD 20:10:24:04, which require companies that have received a local exchange or interexchange certificate of authority, respectively, to file certain information to be filed by June 1 of each year.

On June 25, 2026, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and Comments Due July 13, 2026, to interested persons and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments have been filed to date.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31, and ARSD chapters 20:10:24 and 20:10:32.

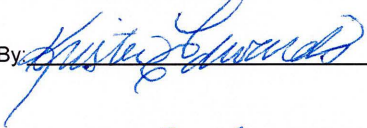
At its regularly scheduled meeting on July 14, 2026, this matter came before the Commission for consideration and action. The Commission voted unanimously to grant a waiver in ARSD 20:10:32:12 and ARSD 20:10:24:04, continuing until such time as the Commission otherwise orders. It is therefore

ORDERED, that ARSD 20:10:32:12 and ARSD 20:10:24:04 are waived for all reporting companies until such time as the Commission otherwise orders.

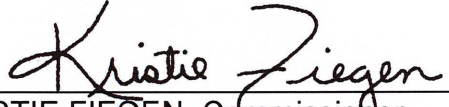
